BOYS AND GIRLS JUNIOR SECTIONS 2010-11

The new England Hockey Board Single System for player development has been in place for a year. Initial results are very encouraging but it is a system that is still developing and we would welcome any feedback from coaches, teachers, parents or players.

There will be two Junior Development Centres (JDCs) within the county to which all hockey players are invited

These will be held at Repton/Foremark School and Anthony Gell School, Wirksworth. Dates and times are in the booklet.

The Centres will be led by Level 2 coaches and are the first rung on the ladder of the player pathway. The emphasis for the JDCs is skill development and players will have the opportunity to practise their skills in competition with neighbouring JDCs. Players will be assessed and possibly selected for progression to Junior Academy Centres (JACs). These will run after Christmas. The JACs replace the County teams and will compete with JACs from other Counties. Those players not progressing to JACs will be encouraged to continue with school and club hockey and will be provided with information on local activity until the JDCs begin again the following season. It is important that all junior players attend a JDC to progress through the system. There is no direct entry to the JACs unless a player is returning from a higher level.

Junior players wishing to attend a JDC should choose the one closest and most convenient for them and complete the registration form (attached as a separate document). If the dates for a local JDC aren't convenient players are free to travel to another centre for their coaching either within Derbyshire or in a neighbouring County/Region. Please note that due to numbers all U16 & U17 Boys and Girls will attend the JDC at Wirksworth.

There will also be School competitions at U13, U14, U16 and U18. More information is provided later in the booklet.

All schools and clubs wishing to participate in competitions must complete the affiliation form enclosed in this booklet to ensure that the organisers have up to date information and contact details.

FAQs

Which Centre Should I attend?

Please attend the Centre that is closest or most convenient for you. However, as the first coaching in Wirksworth will be a whole day delivery players from the South of the county may want to consider attending.

Which age group should I attend?

U13 are those children born in 1998 or after, **U14** born 1997, **U15** born 1996, **U16** born 1995 and **U17** born 1994.

What do I need to bring with me?

You need to bring the Registration form and payment for each session. A full day at Wirksworth or Repton/Foremark will be £12. The 3 hr sessions at Repton will be £6

You will also need a hockey stick, shin pads, a gum shield and a drink. If attending one of the whole day sessions a packed lunch will be needed. Remember to put in a waterproof and change of clothes if it looks like rain or sun block if it is going to be a sunny day!

Parental Guidelines

- Help your child recognize good performance, not just results
- Insist your child uses protective equipment such as mouth guards and shin pads

DIRECTIONS TO VENUES

Anthony Gell School (DE4 4DX)

Wirksworth Leisure Centre

01629 824717

Travelling along A6 from Derby turn left at traffic lights in Cromford up the hill. Pass under the High Peak Trail bridge, down the hill into Wirksworth. Pass through the town, turning left just before mini-roundabout onto Water Lane. Hannage Way is first left. Parking past the Health Centre.

Belper Hockey Club (DE56 1BA)

Take the A6 north from Derby for 8 miles following signposts to Matlock. Go through the villages of Duffield and Milford until reaching the town of Belper. Keep on the A6, passing over an island with Morrisons on your left, and carry on through the town centre. Just 10 metres before the next traffic lights, at the junction of the A6 and the A517 to Ashbourne, turn left over the cobbles and take the entrance after the Church signposted Belper Town Football Club. This leads to Belper Meadows Sports Club and the astroturf pitch.

Foremark Hall (DE65 6EJ)

From the roundabout at the Junction of the A38 and A50, take the B5008 signposted Willington and Repton. Proceed along this road for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to the double roundabout in the centre of Willington. At the first roundabout take the 2nd exit and at the subsequent roundabout take the 1st exit signposted Repton B5008. Continue along this road for just over 1 mile into the centre of Repton and at the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Brook End, signed to Melbourne. Continue along this road for 1 mile into the centre of Milton and turn left signposted Foremark and Ingleby. The main entrance to the school can be found on the right hand side after approximately 1 mile.

Repton School (DE65 6FH)

Take A38 from Derby towards Birmingham. At B5008 Willington/Repton turn left. Continue through Willington to Repton. On approaching the village turn right at the 30mph sign into school grounds

Shobnall Leisure Centre, Burton (DE14 2BB)

Take A38 towards Burton. Leave A38 at Burton South (Branston). Turn left at the roundabout and left again at mini roundabout. At next roundabout, McDonalds on right hand side, take second exit clearly signposted Shobnall Leisure Centre and Hospital A&E. Cross straight over three mini roundabouts and at next roundabout turn left. Go over bridge, turn right into Shobnall fields, opposite Marstons Brewery.

St Marys School, Newbold ,Chesterfield (S41 8AG)

Take A61 Chesterfield to Sheffield road. At first roundabout from Chesterfield, with Tesco on it, take 1st exit. At mini roundabout take 2nd exit up hill into Peveril Road. Take 2nd left into Highfield Lane. At mini roundabout turn right. At next mini roundabout straight across. Take right hand lane at traffic lights, go straight ahead. After traffic lights take second left into Helmsley Close, turn immediately left into car park.

St Benedict RC School, Duffield Rd, Darley Abbey, Derby. (DE22 1JD)

The school is on the A6 between Derby city centre and the junction with the A38. From Derby city centre follow the A6 signed to Matlock. At the roundabout go straight on, remaining on the A6. Continue for approximately another 500 meters. The school is on the left before the junction with the A38. To access the school from the A38 follow signs for the A6, signed to Derby and Matlock. Follow the A6 towards Derby city centre and the school is on the right about 800 meters from the A38/A6 junction.
